

3 Steps to EMERGENCY PREPAREDNESS



Step 1 SAFETY EQUIPMENT

Goggles
Full Face Shield
Chemical Resistance Gloves (rated for appropriate temperature level)
Chemical Resistant Boots
Emergency Showers/Eye Wash Station
First aid Kit
Full Face Gas Mask (concentrations less than 500 ppm or the IDLH)
Positive Pressure Self-Contained Breathing Apparatus (concentrations greater than 500 ppm or the IDLH) *
Chemical Resistant Suits (rated for ammonia)
2 - Way Radio
Hearing Protection (earplugs)



Step 2 TOOLS

Rescue Rope
None-Sparking Pipe Wrench
Ammonia Rated Purge Hose
Portable Monitoring Equipment
Flashlights
Water Hose w/Mist Nozzle
Portable Ventilation Fans



Step 2 TRAINING

Employees should be knowledgeable of all applicable system safety procedures
Employees wearing personal protective equipment must be trained in its proper use
Equipment must be cleaned, inspected and maintained according to manufacturer's recommendations at least monthly and after each use
